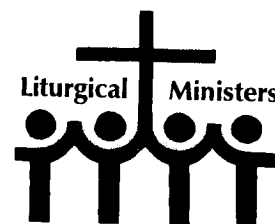

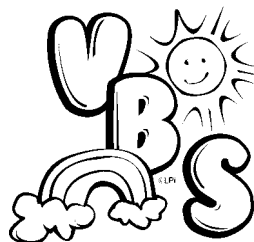


Introducing the Youth Group Basket Raffles

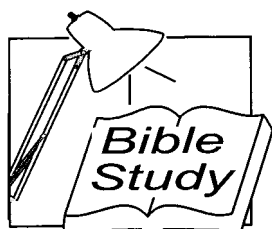

Alma M. Faucher Memorial
Stewardship Award**

"For I was hungry and you gave me to eat; I was thirsty and you gave me to drink; I was a stranger and you took me in; naked and you covered me; Sick and you visited me; I was in prison and you came to see me."
Matthew 25: 35-37
