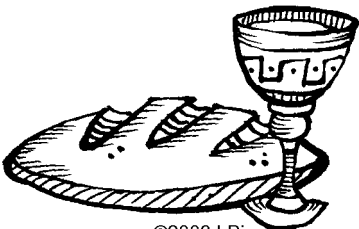

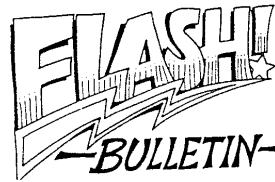

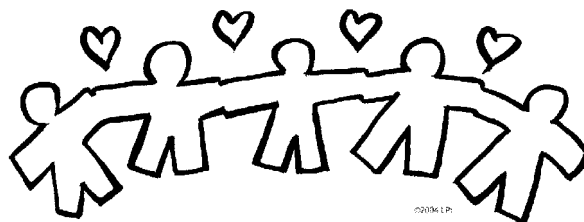
## Knights of Columbus
