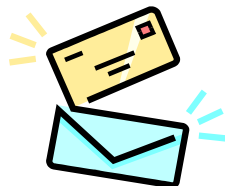

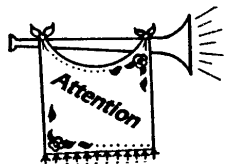

#### **YEAR FOR PRIESTS 2009 ~ JUNE 19 ~ 2010**

"Evangelization consists of proclamation, witness, dialogue and service. It is based on three inseparable elements: preaching the Word, sacramental ministry and leading the faithful. Preaching would be senseless unless it include continuous formation of the faithful and participation in the sacraments. Likewise, participation in the sacraments without sincere conversion of heart, full acceptance of the faith and of the principles of Christian morality is also meaningless. From a pastoral perspective, the primary action of evangelization is, logically, considered to be preaching. From the perspective of intentionality, however, the primary element of evangelization must be celebration of the sacraments, especially of Penance and the Blessed Eucharist. The integrity of the pastoral ministry of priests in the service of new evangelization is to be found, however, in a harmonious fusion of both of these functions.

## 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration

### TIMES GONE BY...

During the 1950's there are recorded 247 Baptisms, 148 Confirmations, 190 First Communions, 68 marriages, and 71 deaths. During the Korean War, another member of the parish, Jerry McMann, died on the field of honor.

Father Samuel Dugan became the fourth Pastor of Saint Agnes Parish. In his relatively brief period of stewardship, from September 1958 to May 1960, he quietly and energetically accomplished much. During his term of service the first Parish Hall was erected. It was purchased from the Bangor Barracks of Dow Air Force Base for the sum of \$1.00 and through the efforts of a very devoted parishioner it was then moved in sections to the parish property. It was then carefully reassembled. It remains as the front section of our greatly enlarged parish Hall.

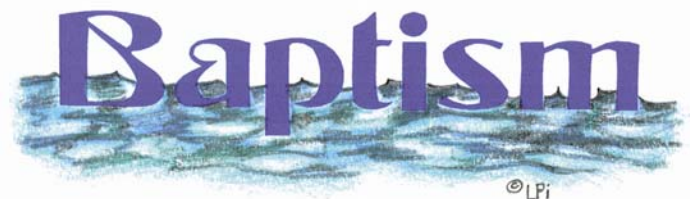
