After completing his studies at St. Mary's Seminary & University in Baltimore, he was ordained to the priesthood on June 4, 2005. Since ordination, Fr. Ouellette has served Good Shepherd Parish with churches in Biddeford and Saco and more recently, St. Paul the Apostle Parish with churches in Bangor, Brewer, Hampden and Winterport.

Father Girardin was genial and much beloved. He proved to be a most popular clergyman. His presence at local civic affairs won him and the Catholic Church universal respect throughout central Maine. In 1962 St. Agnes Parish pledged and paid the sum of \$1,000.00 toward the construction of Sebecook Valley Hospital. The parishioners were proud to have the name of their parish inscribed on the bronze honor roll in the lobby at the new Hospital.

A highlight of Father Girardin's pastorship was the construction of the new two-story rectory adjoining the Church. The Dedication of the new rectory was observed on October 28, 1963. An Open House was held between the hours of 2:00 and 4:00 P.M. and 177 persons visited the new home.
